Look For Me is a collective of networks striving to end the crisis we now call MMIWR (Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Relatives). Our goal as a collective is to empower this high risk and targeted group, through support in Unity and Love.

We shall not work with or affiliate with any groups, organizations or persons who exploit MMIWR in any way. We shall never take from families or allow anyone to take anything from the families again.

We are a group of volunteers who provide guidance and support in search and rescue efforts and coordination, preventive measures, survivor support, and as a point of entry for Native Search Solutions database.

Anyone who does reach out for help, funds will be explained in full. Also, anyone with any knowledge of someone in an abusive situation or needs help with addictions or housing, please reach out to your local chapter house or MMIWR group near you to see what resources are available. If you have resources to offer, please also reach out to local chapter houses or MMIWR groups to see what they need.

All donations received directly fund operations and go to provide relatives and community support. Flights, Uber rides, motels, food, clothes, etc. are all needed to transport and provide comfort for victims as we get them to safety, and to support preventive measures. Survivor support is crucial in ending forced generational cycles and to begin healing the circle. As volunteers, a lot of this has been funded personally, and ALL donations go toward relative and volunteer needs, in all communities of need. Prayer Runs and Walks are also funded in part by donations received. Bringing Prayer and awareness to the most affected areas is critical. Opening conversations with our youth to educate them on signs of controlling behavior, self-esteem, and self-awareness is necessary. Not only teaching our girls how to protect themselves, but also to teach our sons to be respectful to our girls and each other. Education and action, in addition to networking with others who are aligned with the vision and putting in work the right way, is how we begin to change and heal. Together, in Unity.
